

2026 Prestwick Men's Club Game Descriptions

2-Person & 4-Some Events: 90% of handicap

Individual Events: 100% of handicap

- 1) Scrambles: For those who are unfamiliar with the scramble format, it is where everyone in the group tees off. From there you select the ball from where you want to play the next shot from. The other players in the group pick up and place their ball next to the selected shot. You do this on every shot all the way around the course, including on your putts. If you pick a shot in the rough, all players must play their shot from the rough. If you pick a ball on the fringe all players must play their shot from the fringe, etc. If you are a group of 3 players, each hole one player in the group will hit 2 shots. The extra shot is rotated evenly among the group over the course of the round. The handicap allocation is 25% to the highest handicap in the group, 20% to the next highest handicap, 15% to the next highest handicap and the player in the group with the lowest handicap will get 10% of their handicap.
- 2) Pick Your Partner – Best Ball: When you check in for your round you will select who you would like to your partner to be, it can be anyone who is playing in the Men's Club event that morning, meaning it does not need to be someone in your group. It will be scored as a best ball between the two of you. Lowest overall total will be the winner.

- 3) 2-3 Ball: 2 best of 4 on the front 9, 3 best of 4 on the back 9
- 4) Individual Low Net: The total score minus total handicap.
- 5) 2 By 4: 2 best of 4, except there are 4 random holes where ALL balls count
- 6) 6-6-6: This format you will choose a partner to be paired with for the round. The first 6 holes you will play best ball, the next 6 holes you will play alternate shot and the last 6 holes you will play scramble.
- 7) Best Ball 4-Some – Chicago Points: On each hole the best net score will count towards the game results. The point system is 3 for Eagle, 2 for Birdie, 1 for Par and 0 for Bogey and -1 for a Double Bogey or worse. The group with the highest point total will be the winner.
- 8) **Prestwick Classic:** This is a two-day member/member, partner event that spans over a Saturday and Sunday. The Saturday format is Best Ball – Chicago Points, the format on Sunday is both balls count – Chicago Points. Pairings for Sunday are organized by Saturday's results. The better you do on Saturday, the later you tee off on Sunday.

- 9) Par 3, Par 4, Par 5: best ball counts on the par 3's, 2 best of 4 balls will count on the par 4's and 3 best of 4 will count on the par 5's.
- 10) **Men's Club Championship:** This is a two-day event that will span over a Saturday and Sunday. The format will be individual low net and have various flights. We will have a gross division for the championship flight and the winner will be our club champion for the season. Championship flight is from the black tees, net division plays from the white tees.
- 11) **Prestwick Senior Championship:** This is a two-day individual low net event that will take place on a Saturday and Sunday for any member in the Men's or Senior league that is 55 or older. There are two different flights, a gross division from the white tees and a net division from the gold tees.
- 12) **Two Person Best Ball:** The best net score between you and your partner per hole is utilized. The team with the lowest overall score wins. If there are only 3 in your foursome the Pro Shop will blind draw a partner for the bottom name on the scorecard.
- 13) **2 Best of 4:** On each hole the 2 best of 4 net scores will count towards the game.
- 14) **Friday Hustle:** This is a blind draw cash game that is scored as a best ball event, you will receive a random partner from Golf Genius. The best net score between you and your partner per

hole is utilized. The team with the lowest overall score wins. The entry fee is \$20 for the game, \$10 each for net and gross skins. All hustles are played from the white tees.

- 15) Holiday Events - Memorial Day and Labor Day: Any member at Prestwick is welcome to participate and play in these!! The format is a 2 best of 4
- 16) Best Odd Holes with Handicaps: Only the odd holes will count towards the game, your handicap strokes are applied.
- 17) Best Even Holes with Handicaps: Only the even holes will count towards the game, your handicap strokes are applied.
- 18) Individual Stableford: The results of the game will be based on how many points you earn during your round. The points are as follows. 3 for eagle, 2 for birdie, 1 for par, 0 for bogey and -1 for double or worse.
