Weekly Events Description

Peoria Scoring: (No handicap required) After teeing off, 6 holes for the 18-hole league and 3 holes for the 9 hole leagues will be selected. Each player's score on the selected holes will be totaled and used to convert a handicap for the day. The actual score minus the player's handicap will determine the Net Score Winner.

Low Putts: (No handicap required) Keep track of your putts. If you chip in, it is a "0". The player with the lowest number of putts for the round wins.

Two Person Best Ball: The best handicap score between you and your partner per hole is utilized. The team with the lowest overall score wins. If there are only 3 in your foursome the Pro Shop will blind draw a partner for you.

Par 4 Event: The lowest score on all of the Par 4's, with your handicap.

Individual Stableford Scoring: Event is based on a plus/minus system, with handicap.

Eagle = +3 points Birdie = +2 points Par = +1 points Bogey = 0 point Double Bogey = -1 points

Best Odd/Even Holes: On the odd holes it will be 3 best of 4, for the even holes it will be 2 best of 4

Individual Low Net: The total score minus total handicap.

Guess Your Score: When you check in before your round you will tell the golf shop what you think you will shoot for a total score (9 or 18 holes) The person who guesses the closest will be the winner.

3 Clubs and a putter: Select 3 clubs and a putter, leave the rest of your clubs in the car

Proxy Day: On each hole we will have a proxy available for every person to try and win.

Best Ball 4-some: the best net score on each hole will be counted towards the game.

Best Even Holes with Handicaps: Only the even holes will count towards the game, your handicap strokes are applied.

Best Odd Holes with Handicaps: Only the odd holes will count towards the game, your handicap strokes are applied.

1-2-3 Ball: Holes 1-3 1 ball counts, hole 4-6 2 balls count, holes 7-9 3 Balls count

2 Best of 4: On each hole the 2 best of 4 net scores will count towards the game.

Scramble: Everyone tees off and you pick the best shot out of everyone's tee ball to play from. We do this on every shot all the way around the course, including putting. You will have one score per group per hole. If you only have 2 or 3 players you will rotate the extra shot(s) so each group is hitting 4 balls per shot.

Club Championship: This is an individual low net tournament that will be played over the course of 3 weeks. Due to our large league sign up this year you can only play in 2 of the 3 rounds to give each person in the league an opportunity to play. Both scores will be used to determine the winners of each league. There will be a low gross winner and a low net winner for each of the three leagues. Each golfer can only qualify as the winner for one event. To qualify, a participant must have a USGA handicap; be a member of the Prestwick Women's League; and played a minimum of 5 rounds in the weekly events at Prestwick in the 2022 season prior to the Championship Rounds.

Weekly Event Prizes

Weekly event winners receive merchandise credit to be used in the Pro Shop. Credit cannot be used for green fees, lessons or carts. The Pro Shop will keep record of credit accumulated. Credits in the Pro Shop must be used by the end of the season. Weekly event winners will be posted online. The top 3 places for Tuesday 9 hole and top 3 for Tuesday 18 hole as well as the top 5 places on Wednesday will receive prizes. After each event, scorecards must be turned into the Pro Shop. Members must play with at least one other women's club member during league play to compete in the game of the day. A minimum of 8 golfers must complete the round for a pay out to be made. A minimum of 6 golfers must complete the round for a payout to be made for the Tuesday 9 hole league. If an event is cancelled due to weather, the prize money will be used the next available league day, as proxies. The scorecard must be signed and attested. Questions should be referred to the Pro Shop staff or a member of the Board. Please note any Birdies and Eagles by writing your name and the Hole # on the bottom of the scorecard the day you get it.
